

Hills City Council Meeting  
March 25, 2024 / 5:30 PM / Hills Community Center

The regular Hills City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Kemp at 5:30 PM on Monday, March 25, 2024 at the Hills Community Center.

Present: Council Members: Hudachek, Knebel, Sommers, Volk. Absent: Rummelhart. Also present: Sedlacek, City Admin; Frembgen Kesner, Deputy Clerk; and Pantel, Public Works/Fire Chief.

**Consent Agenda:** Volk motioned to approve consent agenda items (March 11, 2024 meeting minutes, scheduled claims list and receipts from March 8, 2024-March 21, 2024) and Sommers seconded. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Public Comment:** B. Dutka suggested that if ICCSD does close to consider using our donation money towards transportation for those who are wanting to open enroll in a different school district. She also asked if any upgrades could be done to the playground structures at the park. She thanked the people who took time to get signatures in the community.

**Business:** Sommers motioned to approve Resolution 2024-04 Extending No Parking Zone on 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Hudachek seconded. Ayes: Sommers, Knebel, Volk, Hudachek. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Sommers motioned to approve Resolution 2024-05 to Approve Project Funds Over \$5,000 for the Songbird Sanctuary Park Funded for by \$50,000 REAP Grant and Knebel seconded. Ayes: Hudachek, Volk, Knebel, Sommers. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Discussion on changing trash and recycling pick up day to Wednesdays instead of Tuesdays, which is Johnson County Refuse's busiest day right now. Council is interested and wants more info.

**Reports:** Attorney: No report.

Mayor: Reminded everyone of the school board meeting on March 26<sup>th</sup>. Mentioned how the school board had refused coming down here to speak with the Hills community.

City Administrator: Let council know about Town and Country plans for 4<sup>th</sup> of July festivities at the park this year. Proposed property tax notices were sent out by the county and we will have public hearing on April 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:40PM.
