

Hills City Council Meeting
July 8, 2024 / 7:00 PM / Hills Community Center

The regular Hills City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Kemp at 7:00 PM on Monday, July 8, 2024 at the Hills Community Center.

Present: Council Members: Hudachek, Knebel, Rummelhart, Sommers, and Volk. Absent: None. Also present: Kemp, Mayor; Sedlacek, City Admin; Frembgen-Kesner, Deputy Clerk; and Pantel, Fire Chief/Maintenance.

Consent Agenda: Knebel motioned to approve consent agenda (June 24th, 2024 annual township minutes and June 24th, 2024 minutes, scheduled list of claims, receipts from June 21-July 3, budget report and treasurer's report) and Rummelhart seconded. Ayes: 5. Motion carried.

Public Comment: A. Hanson would like to know what the city plans to do with the fire department and 4th of July events. She was disappointed that the fire department was not in the 4th of July parade and would like to see a resolution between the fire department and the organization that put on the parade. S. Hudachek said there was a good turnout for the 4th of July events. Described how Hills Town and Country and the City of Hills is separate. She would like the City of Hills to find a solution between both organizations and said that people only heard one side of the story with social media. K. Septer mentioned that the Hills Fire Department has had issues with Hills Town and Country for many years but when things were said to a neighboring fire department last year after the 4th of July parade, that was their cut off.

Ayes: Rummelhart, Knebel, Hudachek, Volk, Sommers. Nays: None. Motion carried.
