Utilities/Services

Water and Sewer

The City of Hills provides water and sewer services for its residents. Water meters are read on the last workday of the month; bills go out on or about the 1st of the following month and are due on the 20th of the month. We accept cash, check and ACH as payment.

Additional water, per 1,000 gallons	\$ 5.00
Sewer (Residential)	\$ 40.00
Special Assessment	\$ 10.00
Deposit (Renters)	\$ 100.00

Trash and Recycle

The City of Hills contracts with Johnson County Refuse to provide trash and recycling service, with pick up on Tuesdays. Charges are included on the water and sewer bill. Residents have a choice between 35- or 65-gallon trash carts. Recycle carts are 65-gallon.
