The regular Hills City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Tim Kemp at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, May 11, 2020 at the Hills Fire Station Meeting Room.

Council discussed cancelling meeting set for May 25, 2020, Memorial Day. A Motion was made by Sommers and seconded by Volk to cancel meeting. Ayes: 5. Motion carried.

Resolution 2020-23 was presented approving and authorizing the Mayor to execute an Agreement with Johnson County Refuse for garbage and recycling collection. A Motion was made by Sommers and seconded by Knebel to approve Resolution 2020-23. Roll Call: Ayes: Sommers, Knebel, Volk, Hill, Peters. Resolution 2020-23 approved.
