The regular Hills City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Tim Kemp at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, November 27, 2017 at the Hills Fire Station Meeting Room.

Present: Mayor Tim Kemp. Council members: Steve Harris, Merle Hill, Bruce Endris and Cathy Knebel. Absent: Thom Kirkpatrick. Also present: Cathy Fitzmaurice-Hill, City Administrator, Ron Wolfe, Public Works, Matt Pantel, Public Works and Asst. Fire Chief, and Johnson County Sheriff, Lonny Pulkrabek.

**Consent Agenda:** A Motion was made by Knebel and seconded by Endris to approve the consent agenda approving agenda, minutes from November 13, 2017 meeting, scheduled list of claims, and receipts from November 11, 2017 thru November 22, 2017. Ayes:4. Motion carried.

**Business:**

Johnson County Sheriff, Lonny Pulkrabek, was present to discuss any issues and the future contract for police protection. He provided information on the number of hours provided to the City in the last year and recommended the Council consider raising the number of contracted hours. Currently the City contracts for 667 hours per year and the department normally provides about 9 extra hours each month. He recommended an increase to 728 hours/year which would increase the annual contract price by \$2,623.00. The Council also discussed dog issues and parking enforcement.

Resolution 2017-35 was presented setting Calendar Year 2017 compensation for volunteer Fire Department Members. The total proposed for this year is \$3,550, determined by using the Stipend policy previously approved. The Fire Association has paid \$1575 for its share of the Stipends as agreed. A Motion was made by Hill and seconded by Endris to approve Resolution 2017-35. Roll Call: Ayes: Hill, Endris, Knebel. Abstain: Harris. Absent: Kirkpatrick. Resolution 2017-35 approved.
