The Special Hills City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Tim Kemp at 11:12 a.m. on Sunday, January 28, 2018 at the Hills Fire Station Meeting Room.

**Consent Agenda:** A Motion was made by Hill and seconded by Volk to approve the consent agenda approving agenda, Ayes:3. Motion carried.

**Business:**

City Administrator provided information on the purchase of a skid steer loader for the Public Works Department. The Council had directed Matt to request at least 2 bids for the equipment and make a recommendation on to the Council. The bids received include:

Farmers Supply Sales, Inc.	\$30,376.00
Bobcat of Iowa City	\$26,921.43

The Farmers bid includes a 100" bucket and a broom for the loader. The Bobcat bid includes a 88" bucket and no broom. It is estimated that the additional cost for these items would be over \$5000.00 resulting in an estimated total bid from Bobcat at \$31,921.43.

The lowest responsive bid is Farmers Supply Sales, Inc.

Resolution 2018-04 was considered approving and authorizing the Mayor to sign purchase order for Public Works Equipment. The resolution approves the purchase of the Farmers Supply Sales, Inc. bid as the lowest responsive bid. A Motion was made by Hill and seconded by Volk to approve Resolution 2018-04.
