

Hills City Council Meeting

The regular Hills City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Kemp at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, August 9, 2021 at the Hills Community Center.

The Council discussed a pump repair at the sewer lagoon. A motion was made by Sommers and seconded by Goldsmith to allow Electric Pump to repair the pump. Ayes: 4. Motion carried.

The Council discussed the Community Center roof installation. Additional parts are needed which may impact the final price. Installation is planned next week.
